

WIDOW OF FORMER MERCHANT DEAD

Word was received in the city this afternoon of the death of Mrs. Hannah Neuman, widow of Simon Neuman, a pioneer merchant of this city.

Death occurred yesterday at her home in Duluth, after a lingering illness with complication of diseases. She was 70 years old, and leaves to survive her, a brother, Mr. William Hoffman of Green Bay, and two daughters and two sons residing at Duluth.

Mr. Simon Neuman, now deceased, was a member of the firm of Neuman & Centrovitz, merchants of this city. About twenty-four years ago, Mr. Neuman passed away and Mrs. Neuman and family left La Crosse going to Duluth where they have since made their home.

The remains will arrive in La Crosse at 11 o'clock Sunday evening and the funeral will take place Monday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the residence of Mr. A. Hirshheimer, 22 North Sixth street, and interment will take place at the Jewish cemetery.
