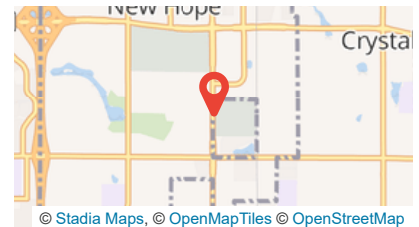
Obituary for Helen B. Rosen
