ELLIOT SCHRIER OBITUARY

Elliot Schrier Died peacefully in Palo Alto on March 25, 2006 at age 80 from Acute Respiratory Disease Syndrome. He is survived by his wife, Nancy, three children Eric, Ellen and Paul, and 7 grandchildren.

A graduate of Michigan State University and an Army veteran of the Pacific theatre in World War II, Elliot was born in Chicago in 1925 but lived most of his life on the Peninsula. He attended graduate school at Stanford University where he met his wife of 55 years. Although Elliot started his career as a western editor for McGraw-Hill Publications, he spent most of his working life as the founding president of a transportation consulting company, Manalytics Inc., with services that spanned the globe. After his retirement, Elliot became active as a volunteer board member and then Chair of the more than 30 Parkinson's Patient Support Groups throughout central California.

Elliot loved fine wines, great desserts, swimming, reading, jazz and most of all, just spending time with his family. And right to the end, Elliot flashed his witty, offbeat sense of humor.
