

THREE GENERATIONS SURVIVE MRS. SILVER

Duluth Woman Dead—Had 10
Great Grandchildren, 17 Grand-
children and Two Sons.

Ten great grandchildren, 17 grandchildren and two sons survive Mrs. Fanny Silver, age 75, who died yesterday morning at the home of her son, J. L. Silver, 1220 East Fourth street. Infirmities of age caused death.

Funeral services were held in the Silver home late yesterday afternoon. L. Casmir of Adas Isreal synagogue, Third avenue East and Third street, officiated. Burial was in the Jewish cemetery.
