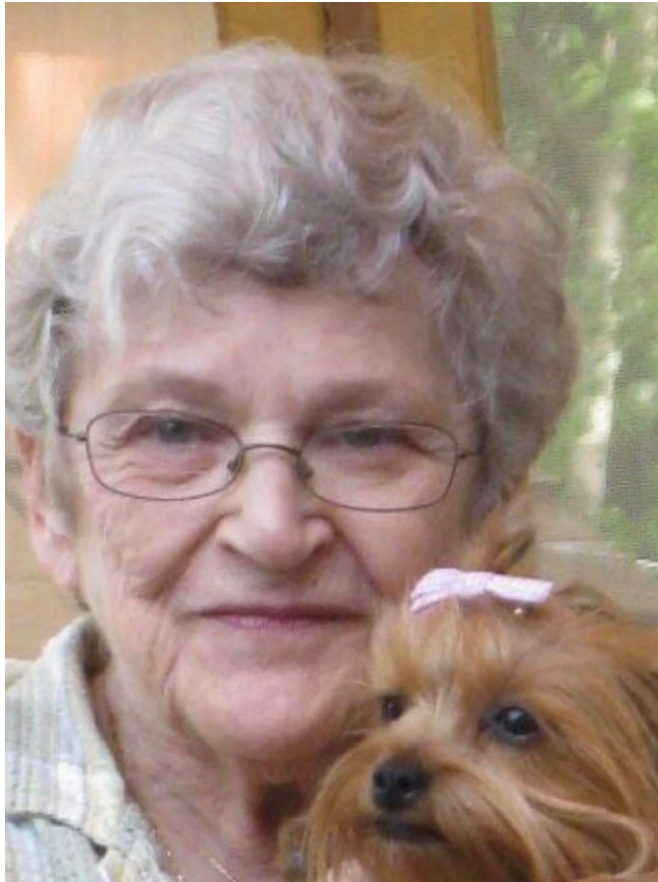


Jane Waltenburg
