Obituary for Paul Warsett

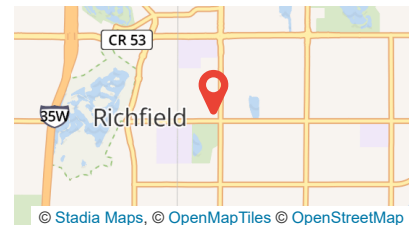
